Financial Aid

The Graduate School of Social Service has financial aid in the form of scholarships and tuition remission grants that it can disperse to doctoral students. Students who receive tuition remission grants must be available to work one or two days per week as research assistants for faculty members.

Decisions about financial aid will be made by the end of May. All decisions will be based on the recommendations of the Admissions Committee and a review of academic records. If you are interested in receiving financial aid directly from the School, you should submit a letter to Dr. G. Lawrence Farmer, Director, Doctoral Program in Social Work outlining your interest and need when you return your acceptance letter and deposit. Prior to sending this letter, you should speak with Dr. Farmer. If you need a decision about financial aid sooner than May, please call Dr. Farmer directly at 212-636-7081.

In addition to aid from the School students are encouraged to apply to governmental and private sources for loans and scholarships. The School will cooperate with all efforts to secure financial aid.
